

Some Tax Information Regarding Light Vehicles

Light vehicles are within the purview of the municipality. Some information regarding these vehicles and paying the appropriate taxes on time follow:

- 1. If you are eligible for a tax light car (*kei*) reduction/exemption due to illness or physical challenges, you need to apply for it as soon as possible. You will need to bring appropriate documentation to prove your status to the Tax Division (*Zeikamuka*) in the City Hall.
- 2. Are you still using a light vehicle? Taxes are calculated from April 1st, so if you have discontinued using a vehicle but have yet to report it you should do so immediately. After April 2nd, you will be responsible for paying the annual tax.

For vehicles with an engine capacity under 125cc, you can do this at the Kakamigahara City Hall Tax desk (TEL: 058-383-4703). Please bring your Vehicle registration, documents, a valid ID, Number plate, personal seal *inkan*(and a proxy statement if another person will be handling this for you/ you are unable to come to the office in person).

For vehicles such as *kei*/light cars, three or four-wheelers, you will need to go to the Gifu Light Vehicle Inspection Association Office (*keijidōsha kensa kyōkai Gifu jimusho*). For more info please contact the office at 050-3816-1775. For motorcycles over 125cc in capacity, please go to the Gifu Transportation Office (*Gifu unyu shikyoku*) at 050-5540-2053.

3. If your car/vehicle is over 13 years old, there was an additional tax created a few years ago that you will need to pay more. If you need to consult someone or have questions, please contact the Tax Division at 058-383-4703.

Meiji Mura Discounted Admissions for Kakamigahara Residents

From March 3rd~April 30th Meiji Mura Park will offer reduced general admissions fees for residents of Kakamigahara City. The adjusted entry prices are Adults: 1500 yen, Seniors (over 65) and University students 1,100 yen, High school Students 800 yen, Middle and Elementary Students 500 yen. Monkey Park Discounted Admissions for Kakamigahara City Residents

From March 3rd~April 30th Monkey Park will reduce the general admissions fee for visitors with proof of residence in Kakamigahara city (Driver license, city ID card, etc). One ID is good for up to 5 people, and includes a discount on the One Day Passports as well. The adjusted prices are: Middle school students and over: 900 yen, children over 2 years 500 yen. One day Passports for over middle school and up: 3100 yen, Elementary students: 2700 yen, children over 2 years 2,100 yen.

Little World Discounted Admissions for Kakamigahara Residents

From March 10th ~April 30th Little World Park will offer reduced general admissions fees for residents of Kakamigahara City.
