

# Kakamigahara City 2018 Sakura Matsuri

The festival takes place in the citizen's park around the Chuo Library April 7<sup>th</sup> (Saturday) and 8<sup>th</sup> (Sunday). This year's list of attractions/events include: The Miss Kakamigahara Meet and Parade on Saturday from 9 AM, performances on the Sakura stage (from 10 AM on Saturday, 9 AM Sunday), Flower viewing pulled rickshaw (jinrikisha) rides around the park (Saturday 10:30 AM-4 PM, Sunday 10:00 AM-4:00 PM), The Sakura Festival Photo Contest (From March 23<sup>rd</sup>~April 10<sup>th</sup>); turn in your work (cherry blossom and festival themed) to the Kankoukouryuka/ Tourism and Multi-Cultural office (Sangyou Bunka Center, 6F) by April 13<sup>th</sup> for consideration, Cherry Blossom viewing along the river with food and other offerings, and the Sakura Matsuri Tea Ceremony (Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 AM~3:00 PM).

The park will also have a BBQ area available for Flower Viewing parties from March 31<sup>st</sup>~April 8<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00 AM~9:00 PM (Note that entry into the BBQ area is prohibited after 7:00 PM).

### Volunteer Japanese Language Courses

Kakamigahara City offers Japanese language courses at the Sangyou Bunka Center for residents. Classes are offered three times on Wednesdays from 6:00 PM, 7:00 PM, and 8:00 PM for about an hour. These are 1-on-1 lessons with a volunteer teacher, and you get to have input on the kind of study (speaking, reading/writing, etc.) as well as the text you will use. Texts and dictionaries are available for use during classes, but students are encouraged to buy their own in order to study outside of the classroom.

The classes are 2,000 yen for 10 classes (10 classes, not 10 weeks, you can skip a week or make other schedule arrangements with us), payable in full at the first class. Again, the classes are taught by volunteer teachers on a 1-to-1 ratio, so please be aware that it may take some time to find a teacher for you, usually from 2 -5 weeks but it can take over a month or even two in some circumstances.
