14th Annual Takenoko (Bamboo Shoot) Festival

The festival will be held on Saturday, May 12th from 10:00 AM (rainy weather may prohibit some events) at the *Kakamino Shizen Isan no Mori*. Events include a play area with things made from Bamboo (such as a slide made from bamboo, water guns, stilts, ring toss, kendama, and so on; a tea spot (100 yen, up to 200 visitors), an chance to try orienteering in the forest (from 2:00 PM), Bamboo crafts (you can make bamboo helicopters, etc.), a photo contest, and some shops. Free soup will be offered to the first 200 visitors (serving from 11:00 AM). Other events include a drink corner, mini steam train (not in the rain), and a balloon art workshop.

There isn't much parking available at the venue, it is suggested you park elsewhere; Kakami Elementary School has been designated a parking space for this event.

Volunteer Japanese Language Courses

Kakamigahara City offers Japanese language courses at the Sangyou Bunka Center for residents. Classes are offered three times on Wednesdays from 6:00 PM, 7:00 PM, and 8:00 PM for about an hour. These are 1-on-1 lessons with a volunteer teacher, and you get to have input on the kind of study (speaking, reading/writing, etc.) as well as the text you will use. Texts and dictionaries are available for use during classes, but students are encouraged to buy their own in order to study outside of the classroom.

The classes are 2,000 yen for 10 classes (10 classes, not 10 weeks, you can skip a week or make other schedule arrangements with us), payable in full at the first class. Again, the classes are taught by volunteer teachers on a 1-to-1 ratio, so please be aware that it may take some time to find a teacher for you, usually from 2 -5 weeks but it can take over a month or even two in some circumstances.
