Monkey Park Admissions Discounts for Citizens

Monkey Park will offer discounted admissions for Kakamigahara City residents until July 1 (Admissions are for the general park only, and entry to the zoo area requires an additional fee). The adjusted rates are: Junior high and up: 900 yen, children over two (and under junior high age): 500 yen. One day pass (covering all rides) is 3100 yen for anyone over junior high age, and 2100 for children 2 and up to junior high age. You must show a form of ID to prove your Kakamigahara Residence, but one ID is valid for up to 5 members.

Volunteer Japanese Language Courses

Kakamigahara City offers Japanese language courses at the Sangyou Bunka Center for interested persons. Classes are offered three times on Wednesdays from 6:00 PM, 7:00 PM, and 8:00 PM for about an hour. These are 1-on-1 lessons with a volunteer teacher, and you get to have input on the kind of study (speaking, reading/writing, etc.) as well as the text you will use. Texts and dictionaries are available for use during classes, but students are encouraged to buy their own in order to study outside of the classroom.

The classes are 2,000 yen for 10 classes (10 classes, not 10 weeks, you can skip a week or make other schedule arrangements with us), payable in full at the first class. Again, the classes are taught by volunteer teachers on a 1-to-1 ratio, so please be aware that it may take some time to find a teacher for you, usually from 2 -5 weeks but it can take over a month or even two in some circumstances.
