

Elementary Students- Take the Overseas Study Program Challenge!

The Kakamigahara International Association's annual Elementary School Overseas Study Program is about to set sail!

The city will select up to 8 students from the 5th and 6th grades from local schools to go to Guam from March 30th-April 2nd (3 nights, 4 days) to study about the native culture, some nature, practice a little English, and learn about the value of peace.

Students who would like to participate can attend the information/explanation on December 10th from 7:00 PM at the *Sangyou Bunka Center* (meeting room 3, located on the 2F). If you are sure you'd like to try, you must submit an application and written essay stating your reasons for wanting to go (application forms are available from local elementary schools, the KIA office, or the KIA website. Essays should be a maximum of 400 characters (preferably in Japanese) and around two A4 sized-pages in length. Applications must be submitted to the KIA office (the *Kankoukouryuka* division on the 6F of the *Sangyou Bunka Center*). Entrants will also have to participate in a face-to-face interview at a date and time to be announced at a later date.

Elementary School Enrollment Confirmation

Confirmation of student enrollment for children entering elementary school will be sent mid-December. Please make sure there are no errors in the name, address, and other information. Be sure to contact the Board of Education if one or more of the following conditions apply :

*Your child will be entering a school other than a municipal one.

- *You have a plan to change your address by April 2020.
- *You receive notification from another municipal government.
- * Your child is unable to enter school due to illness or other unavoidable circumstances. You can contact the School Education Division at TEL 058-383-1118.

For Those Office Workers Regarding Adjustments (Taxes):

Unadjusted year is the adjustment of the difference between the total income tax and the amount for income tax that was collected from the monthly salary and the income tax that one is required to pay in one year.

Those who wish to declare tax deductions for supporting dependents, spouse, etc. should submit the Declaration of Tax Exemption for Dependent (*Fuyōkōjotōshinkokusho*) and/or Declaration of Tax Exemption for Spouse (*Haigūshakōjo-tō shinkoku-sho*) to the workplace.

Please note that you cannot claim the same dependents on two or more people's tax forms! Once only!

If you find you have made any errors or changes need to be made please alert your place of employment as soon as possible to make the tax process as smooth as possible.
