

<u>Library Going Digital: The Kakamigahara Electronic Library</u> (Kakamigahara Denshi Toshokan)

To launch the digital library, Kakamigahara has collected around 100 publishers to create a digital library with around a thousand titles ranging from light novels to picture books for children. This will allow for people unable or concerned about safety to still borrow and read or read to children even during holiday hours or when the library is otherwise closed.

To access:

- 1. Go to the Chuo Library Website and click on the "Denshi Toshokan" (電子図書館) button.
- 2. You will be taken to the log in page. The ID is your library card number. Your password for the first try is your birthdate written as a series of 8 numbers: for example, a birthdate of July 1, 1991 will be entered as: YEARMONTHDAY, or 19910701.
- 3. This will take you to the Main Page section. Here you can browse or search for books. When you find a book you would like to borrow, push the 借りる (*kariru* / borrow) button.
- 4. When you finish, you need to click the 返す (kaesu / return) button.

Routine Child Vaccination Reminders

Note: All ages are from months and years from birth of the child.

Rotavirus (Added to routine immunizations Oct. 1, 2020; children born after August 1, 2020 are eligible for free vaccination). There are two kinds, you will need to choose either Rotarix (1 strain) or Rotateq (5 strain) and use only that type to complete the series. *Both should be undertaken before 14 weeks and 6 days from birth*.
