Reception Desk Service Hours Extended for the Moving Season

Spring often means a lot of people changing addresses and employment. To help with the volume of requests at the city offices, Kakamigahara will be extending the normal weekday hours! The reception desks at both the City Hall Citizen's Services Division and the Unuma Service Center will also have operating hours on some Sundays as follows:

Sunday Hours: March 29, April 5 9:00 AM~5:00 PM

Weekday Hours: March 30-April 3 9:00 AM~7:00 PM

Note that foreign residents may only use the City Hall main office.

Services Available: Address change, Personal Seal Registry, Family/Personal Registry, Municipal ID card, My number Card, and similar clerical services will be available.

Items you need: Personal seal, seal registration, driver's license, passport, or other picture ID or similar documentation.

Tax Filing and Payments

Tax forms are due March 16th.

You can review and file your documents at Masa 21.

Public Housing Available

You can sign up for a 4 year contract, and of course contract renewals are possible.

The available room is 3LDK located in Naka Nishi at the Sunny Heights Hana Midzuki building. The cost of the room is 45,000 yen/month with a deposit of 1.5 months, Monthly Maintenance Fee (4,800 yen per month) and a parking space (1 car) for 2,720 yen additionally per month.

Unuma Jyuku Nakasendo Spring Festival
