My Number Card and Bonus Points...

As a campaign to promote getting the plastic My Number card, there is a special promotion giving 5,000 yen (in points) to those who make a card and link it to a cashless service.

Step 1: Get the card. You can apply by post, smart phone, or pc. After applying, it will take 6-8 weeks to receive your card. You can go to the City Hall for help/support.

Step 2: Sign up for My Number Points using the QR code below to access the website to register for the My No. Points. You can also sign up through the Post Office, Convenience Stores, Cellular Service Shop, and the City Hall. You will need to make a 4-digit security password.

Step 3: Select the cashless service to collect points. At the site in **Step 2**, select the option to establish a My No. Point connection to Cashless Payments and complete the application.

You can also do this at the same locations listed in **Step 2**.

You must have the My Number Card and a 4-digit passcode.

2020 Municipal Sponsored Breast Cancer and Lung Cancer + Tuberculosis Screenings

Breast Cancer Screenings. For women over 40, you should have an examination once every two years. The 2020 exams will be until February 26, 2021, every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday (other than national holidays). Reception is from 1:15 PM~ 2:15 PM, with availability of up to 38 persons a day. The cost is 1500 yen and includes X-Ray and Mammogram. (If you have a pacemaker, or wear medical equipment on your upper body, are pregnant, currently breastfeeding, are undergoing treatment for breast issues, have had breast augmentation, etc., you will not be able to take this exam).

You may make reservations for an exam until January 31, 2021.

Lung Cancer/Tuberculosis Screening This examination is available until November 30, 2020 on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays (other than national holidays) with reception from 2:15 PM~2:45PM. The cost is 1000 yen for those 40-64, free for those 65 and over. Note that other testing that may be required may still add an additional 1,000 yen if required. Reservations until October 30.

Both screenings will be held at the Kakamigahara Tokai Chuo Hospital, 2F at the Health Management Center.

Fees must be paid in full. Please bring exact amounts. Reservations may be made online, by telephone, or in person. Please contact the Health Management Division at 058-383-1115.
