Just a reminder from Citizen's Services Division that you should keep your information up to date. If you move out of the city, be sure to register your leaving, and if possible your new address (definitely in your new city). If you do not, you may suffer a number of inconveniences and hassles at best, accrue penalties at worst. A lot of materials and services, not to mention taxes and other payments, are directly affected by this information.

Also be sure to report a change in address even if you remain in Kakamigahara to the Citizen's Services Division.

Census Time is Upon Us Once Again!

Yes, the time for another 5-year National Census is coming again, so government agents will soon be visiting all homes registered in the country to hand over census materials beginning in mid-September, 2020. Please cooperate and answer the questions as truthfully as possible and be assured the information will be collected and collated, but privacy will be maintained in all instances.

Note: All ages are from months and years from birth of the child.

Hib ; <i>from 2 months ~ 4 years 11 months</i>	BCG; <i>By 11 months of age</i>
Pediatric Pneumococcal Infection; <i>from 2 months ~ 4 years 11 months</i>	Measles/ Rubella <i>Phase 1: 1 year~1 year 11 months, Phase 2: 1 year before entering elementary school</i>
Hepatitis Type B <i>to 11 months of age</i>	Chickenpox <i>1 year~2 years 11 months</i>
DPT-IPV <i>from 3 months ~7 years 5 months</i>	HPV <i>optional; for girls from 13-16 years old</i>
DPT (Triple) <i>from 3 months ~7 years 5 months</i> <i>(Not Required if getting the -IPV version)</i>	DT 2 <i>Phase 11 years ~ before 13. Please contact the Health Management Division if you are 13 but were not inoculated when 12.</i>
Inactive Polio <i>from 3 months ~7 years 5 months</i> <i>(Not needed if taking the DPT-IPV vaccine, or the active two stage polio vaccine)</i>	Japanese Encephalitis <i>Phase 1: 6 months ~ 7 years 5 months, Phase 2: 9 years ~ before 13 years</i>
