The Moving Season Reception Desk Service Has Been Extended

The reception desks at both the City Hall and the Unuma Citizen's Service Center have extended their operation period because of the pandemic emergency declaration. This is for both the weekly and Sunday hours.

Weekdays: March 29~April 2; until 7:00 PM.

The Service Desks can help you with services to do with moving in/out of the city, such as Citizen Moving In, Notification of Moving Away, Family Registry, Citizen's Card Copy, Personal Seal Registration, Personal Seal transfers to Citizen's Card, My Number card assistance.

Please be sure to bring all helpful/necessary materials to establish identity such as your My Number Card, Driver's license, Passport, and/or other photograph ID. If you are moving in from another municipality, be sure to bring your documents of moving away from the previous city hall as well.

Protected/Semi-Protected Children School Support

The city offers additional support for covering school items/supplies and lunch fees. This is available to eligible children enrolled (or will be enrolled as of this April) in municipal elementary and junior high schools. Please consult your local school.

Also, if your family is facing hardships caused by the ongoing COVID pandemic, please be sure to consult your school.

Those eligible must meet any of following conditions: Those who are deemed to need assistance depending on their living conditions, and those are comprehensively certified by the Board of Education: 1. Those who have suspended or stopped receiving assistance according to the Public Assistance Act, 2. Those receiving child-rearing assistance, 3. Those who had their residential taxes waived, 4. Those recognized for having poor living conditions and unstable employment.

Don't Forget to File Your City and Prefectural Residence Taxes

The tax season has arrived. If you need to file, then we suggest you do so promptly as the offices and staff will become very busy.

You can still file at MASA 21 (Until March 15)

9AM~ 5PM, Masa Hall, 4F. NOTE: Will be open on February 21 and 28 (Sunday). You can take a service number (required) using your LINE account or in person (not by telephone). You can also receive consultations until March 30 on weekdays (closed holidays).

Of course you can use the e-tax services online, and can send them directly to the Gifu Minami Tax Office (500-8567 Gifu City, Kanoshimizucho 4-22-2).

Please Report Crows Building Nests on Power Equipment

Crows like to nest on telephone poles, transformers, etc. and can interfere with or damage electrical services. Please make a note of the pole tag (usually a number) and report it to the Chubu Denryoku Kakamigahara Power Grid Office. Also refrain from using wire hangars outside as well as other metallic objects as crows have learned to steal them to make nests, but they will obviously cause a variety of dangerous situations.
