What has been done so far?

A number of things are being done to help foreign residents in the city.

- Foreign language Natural Disaster Handbook
- Translation services at city office counters
- Japanese Lessons for Working People (JICE)
- COVID-19 vaccine reservation support for foreigners

There is also foreign language information posted regularly to the city homepage.

『The Multicultural Coexistence Promotion Plan』

Kakamigahara City is developing a plan to help foreigners in other ways, and make living easier for all its residents.

The details will be announced around May 2023.
